Venom Penetrating Oil

Venom® Penetrating Oil is a mineral oil and solvent based lubricating fluid designed to displace water, loosen "frozen" metal parts, and prevent corrosion. When used on metal parts, Venom® Penetrating Oil sets up a non-staining oil film over the applied area to minimize friction between surfaces and prevent rust and corrosion from occurring.

To use Venom® Penetrating Oil, apply lubricant to appropriate area and wait 15 or more seconds to rusted parts to loosen. For parts that are highly corroded, several applications may be required. After the penetrating oil sets, parts should be freed. For rust and corrosion protection allow a thin film of product to coat metal areas.

Venom® Penetrating Oil can also act as a cleaning solvent on metal parts that are plagued with rusty debris, grease, or general dirt. To use as a cleaner, apply Venom® Penetrating Oil directly on metal surfaces and allow oil to penetrate for 15 or more seconds. Using a cloth or light brush, depending on application, wipe away debris.

Venom® Penetrating Oil also provides excellent rust and oxidation prevention on metal tools and equipment.

Venom® Penetrating Oil works great on:

- Relieving surface rusted "frozen" metal parts such as bolts and screws.
- Preventing rust and corrosion on metal parts.
- General metal lubrication including: door hinges, chains, and wheels.
- Cleaning dirt, grease, and other debris from metal parts.

Always shake or stir product before use as contents can settle and use in well ventilated areas. Avoid contact with eyes; a face shield should be used if face or eye contact is a possibility. Wash skin with soap and water if contact with product is made. Avoid storing product at elevated temperatures. If product is being used as an aerosol, read directions on can for safely storing, handling, and using product.
